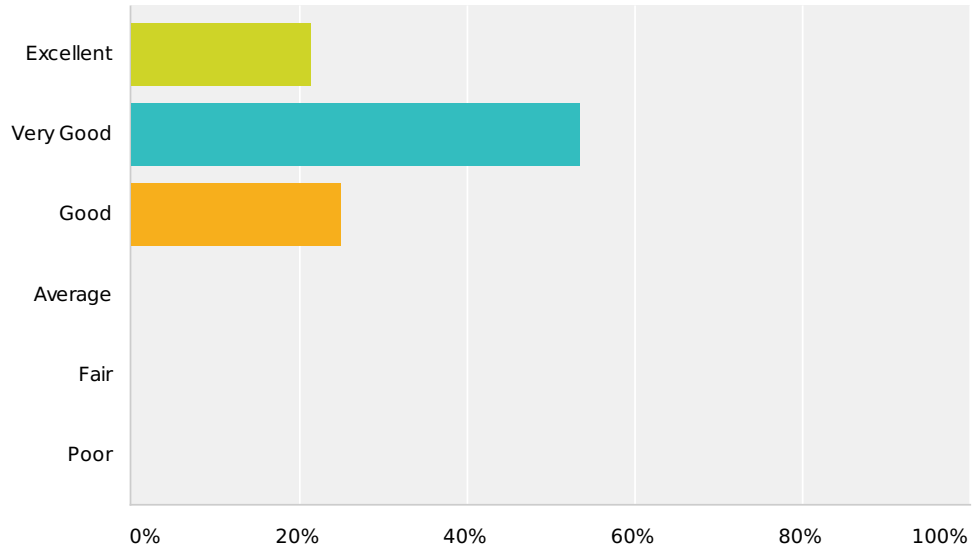


Q1 How would you rate the event overall?

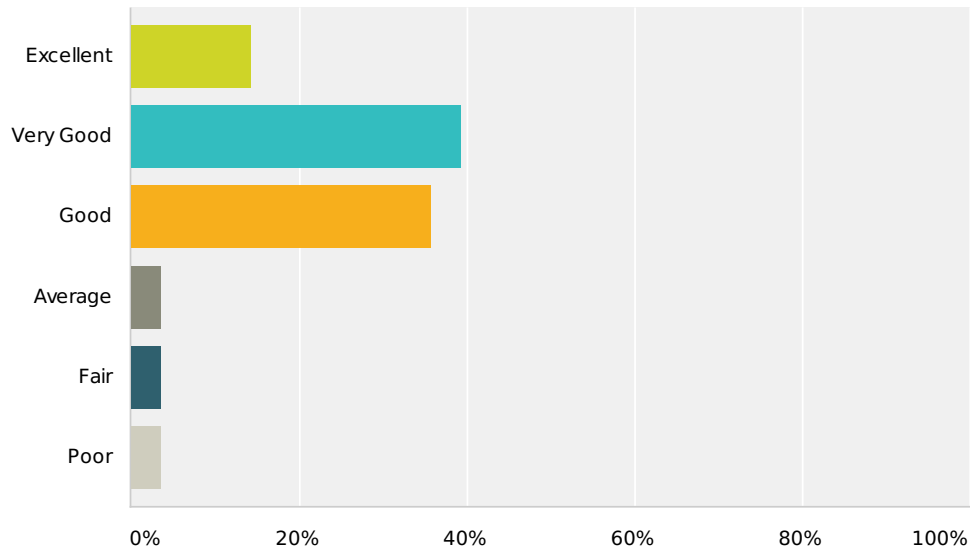

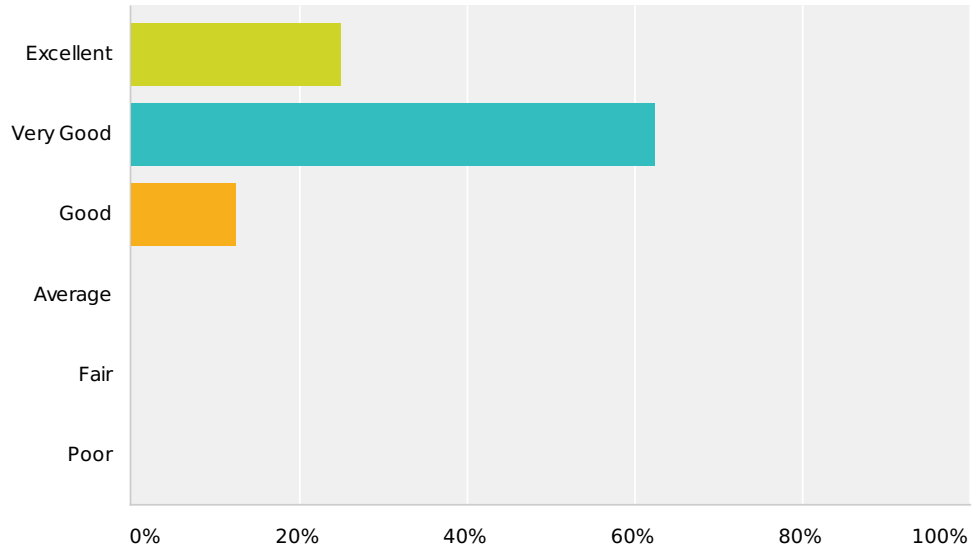

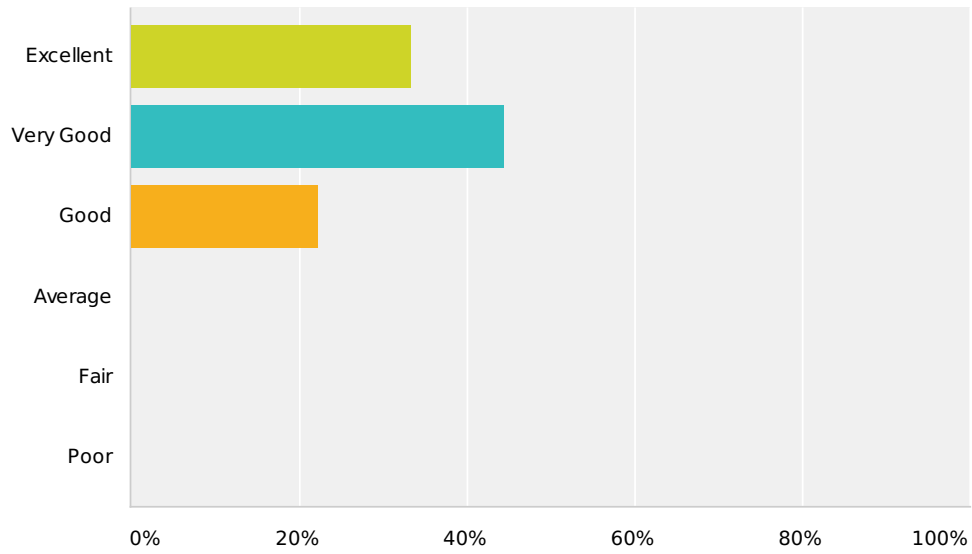

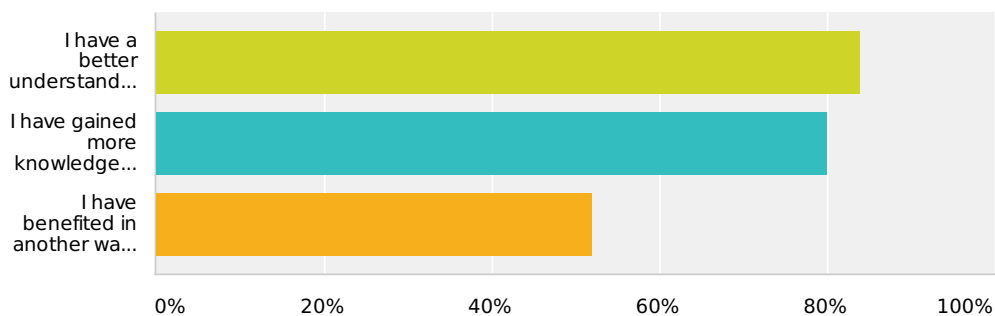

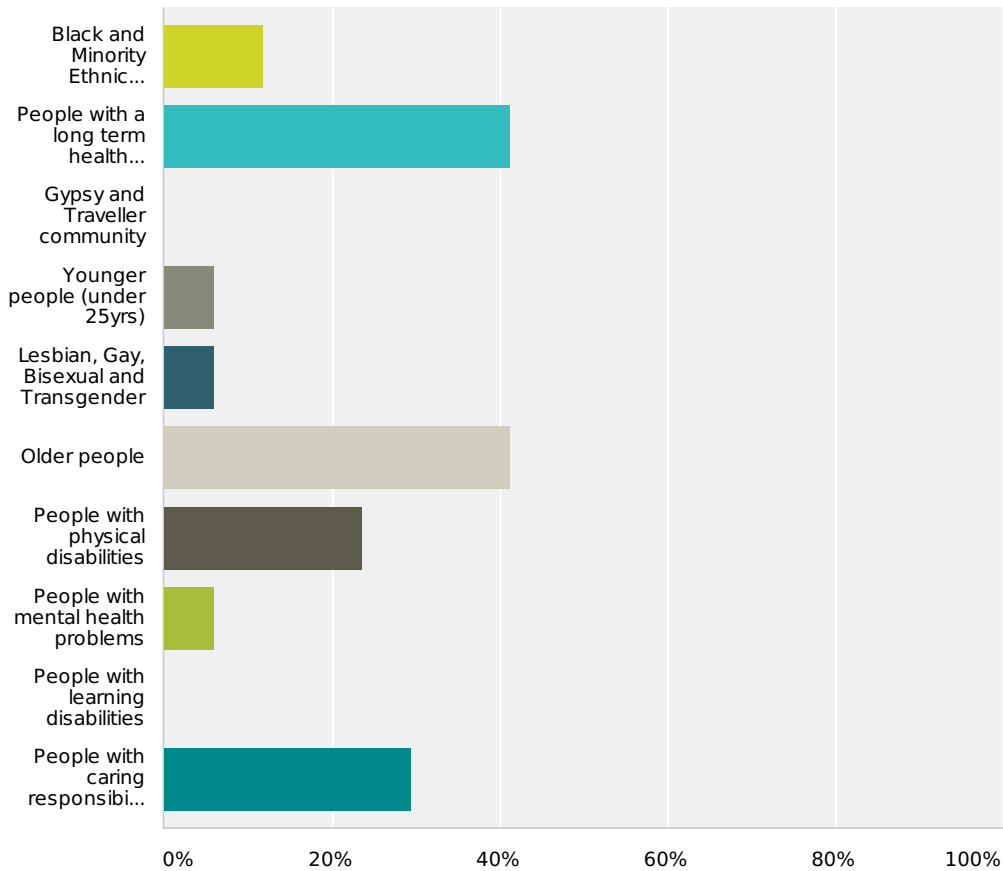
